Why rubbish?

Your per capita rubbish generation in Nairobi is 0.7Kg daily. All together we generate 3000 tonnes of rubbish daily in Nairobi.

Now, I know, I know ... you pay for your rubbish to be collected, but have you any idea how its disposed of?

Everyday in Nairobi, 2100 tonnes of rubbish clog our public drainage, heap on the sides of our roads, fill our rivers, kill our oceans and our environment.

If only rubbish had value!

What is a Community Cooker?

It is a waste-to-energy technology that generates heat energy from rubbish.

A Community Cooker incinerates rubbish at above 880 degrees centigrade to eliminate most toxic gases

Heat energy generated from incinerating rubbish is then used to cook, bake and heat water.

The technology meets US EPA, European and Kenyan Standards for Gaseous Emissions and Ash.

...won't the rubbish smell?

Properly managed waste, that is regularly sorted, and frequently recycled, reused and incinerated will neither be an aesthetic hindrance nor an air pollution.

Rubbish sorting and the Community Cooker kitchens are designed to be separate from one another.
